- **Dragonflies may not exceed 14L"x12W"x8H"**
- **Any recyclable materials may be used that are appropriate for school**
- **Dragonflies will be judged on creativity, construction, materials, attractiveness, theme and artist statement.**
- **Each entry must include student name, art teacher name, grade, school, and district.**
- **The artist statement should be 3-5 sentences in length describing the artistic process of creating the dragonfly and any other important information about connections made to our Delaware dragonflies.**
- **We can only accept 10 student entries per school building! Teachers, please consider a building level contest as necessary to decide school winners!**

1ST, 2ND, AND 3RD PLACE WINNERS WILL BE CHOSEN FOR EACH GRADE LEVEL ELEMENTARY, MIDDLE, AND HIGH FOR EACH COUNTY AND WINNING DRAGONFLIES WILL BE ON DISPLAY AT THE DELAWARE MUSEUM OF NATURE AND SCIENCE!
