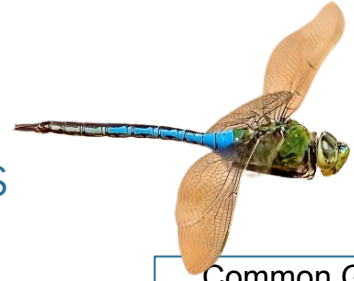

## ARGUMENT ESSAY FOR MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS

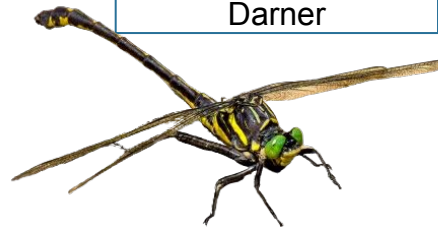
